- North View Junior High and Park Center Senior High are public schools in the Osseo Area School District 279.
- We are an authorized (August, 2007) IB Middle Years Programme.
- Grades 6 through 9 are at North View and grade 10 is at Park Center.
- All North View students and all 10th grade students at Park Center participate in the IB Programme.
- Demographics:
 - 72% students of color
 - 28% white
 - 16% limited English proficiency
 - 11% Special Education
 - 59% free and reduced price lunch
- Over 25 countries are currently represented in our school community.
- World language, either Spanish or French, is required of all students.
- 15 hours per year of Community and Service is required of all students.
- More than 23 after-school programs and resource centers are offered.
- Students may apply for High Performance classes in language A, humanities, science and math
- North View has an 8 period day: Monday, Thursday, and Friday students are in all 8 classes: Tuesday and Wednesday are four period block days.

The International Baccalaureate Programme emphasizes a global perspective that encourages students to become active, compassionate, and lifelong learners.
