Delivering years 1–5 of the International Baccalaureate Middle Years Program, Crosswinds Arts and Science School is the secondary school of the East Metro Integration District. Our students come from St. Paul and 9 surrounding suburban member districts. We are the only IBO school in the State of Minnesota to offer the Middle Years Program, years 1–5, housed in one building. Crosswinds began the implementation process in September, 2004, and was authorized to offer the International Baccalaureate Middle Years Program in July, 2007.
