Champlin Park High School is located northwest of the Minneapolis-St. Paul metropolitan area and serves students in the communities of Champlin, Brooklyn Park, Brooklyn Center, and Dayton.

Champlin Park, one of five high schools in the Anoka-Hennepin ISD #11, graduated its first class in 1993. The district also has six middle schools and twenty-eight elementary schools with a total enrollment of 41,593. The student population at Champlin Park High School is approximately 3,250 in grades 9 through 12.

The curriculum at Champlin Park is comprehensive and includes courses of study to help prepare all students for various post secondary educational experiences. To meet the diverse needs of students, the curriculum includes International Baccalaureate, Advanced Placement, College in the Schools, Honors courses, and Internship programs.

Champlin Park International Baccalaureate Diploma Program

Champlin Park was authorized to begin the International Baccalaureate Diploma Program in May 2006. The 2006/7 school year was the phase-in year with IB classes for junior students only. Senior students and several junior IB students will sit for 190 IB final exams this spring, May 2008.

Approximately 80 twelfth grade students and 110 eleventh grade students are enrolled in one or more IB courses for the 2007/8 school year. About 85 ninth grade students are enrolled in IB-Prep Physics 9 course and about 100 tenth grade students are enrolled in IB-Prep English 10 and IB-Prep Biology.

Only Anoka-Hennepin students may apply to transfer to Champlin Park High as anticipated IB diploma candidates. A-H students may apply to transfer to CPHS by December 1 during their sophomore year
