- Grand Rapids became an IB school in 1983, being the first IB school in Minnesota
- We offer English A1 HL, Spanish SL, French SL, German SL, Chemistry HL, Physics HL, Biology SL, Math Studies SL, Math SL, Business and Management SL, Economics HL, and History HL.
- We had 92 students taking 254 Exams in May 2007
- We have open enrollment and because of the IB program we gain students from other school districts around us. Grand Rapids High School is the only IB school north of the Metro area
- We do not offer AP courses. Grand Rapids High School feels very strong about the curriculum the IB provides and feels it prepares the students in a more rounded way
- We have 68 teachers (9-12) with 20 teachers teaching 1 or more IB or Pre IB courses
- In the 2006-2007 school year, we had 3 diploma candidates successfully complete the IB Diploma requirements
- Based on a score of 0-7, our IB Diploma candidates averaged a score of 5.47
- Any student registered in an IB HL course is required to sit for the exam. Students taking IB SL courses have an option to sit for the exam or not (85% of the SL students opt to take the exam)
- Students pay \$50 for the first exam and \$5 for each additional exam
