Highland Park Senior High was authorized as an IB school in 1994. We have had 91% diploma achievement rate since 1996, the first graduating class.

We offer twenty-one IB level courses and have 58% of the staff trained to teach IB. All but two of these teachers also teach regular level classes. This is one of our central tenets ñ that IB supports the entire school, and the entire school supports IB in return.

In 2006 166 students sat for 366 exams. School average exceeded worldwide in 8 of the 21 areas; they were at the world wide average in 2 areas.

St. Paul has open enrollment: students choose from all over the district. There are no applications or gate-keeping for students wanting to enroll in the program. There are two other IB programs within the district but all have distinct cultures and personalities.

Students have had great success gaining entrance to colleges of all tiers.
